

2026 Swimming Pool Policies

General Pool Rules:

1. Pool Hours:

- The pool will be open from Memorial Day through Labor Day with the following daily hours (*subject to change*):
 - Sunday: 11:00 PM – 7:30 PM
 - Monday – Saturday: 11:00 AM – 7:30 PM
- Patrons must start vacating the pool area by 7:15 PM to allow proper closing procedures to occur.
- The pool may be closed on certain holidays, private events, or for maintenance.

2. Cabanas:

- Right side row is reserved for Adults Only and Left side is for families.
- Cabanas are first come, first served and no “saving” for friends/family that are arriving later.

3. Age Restrictions:

- Children of the age of 18 and under must always be accompanied by an adult or guardian.
- Children under the age of 3 must always wear a swim diaper in the pool.

4. Swimwear:

- Proper swimwear is required (no jeans, non-swimwear materials, or inappropriate attire).
- Swimwear must be clean and free of contaminants.

5. Safety:

- Flotation devices, including but not limited to arm floats and inflatable rings, are not permitted unless approved by lifeguards.
- The pool manager reserves the right to limit the use of flotation devices based on pool conditions or safety concerns.
- No glass is allowed in the pool areas.

6. Behavior:

- All members and guests must register/pay at the front gate prior to entering the pool area.
- Parents/Guardians are expected to monitor their children and guests during their visit. Violations will result in a verbal/written warning, and then membership may be revoked with no refund.

7. Member Guests:

- At check-in, Guests must provide name and pay fees accordingly:

Member Behavior and Code of Conduct

1. All members and guests must exhibit appropriate behavior while using the pool. Aggressive or inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated and may result in removal from the pool area or suspension of membership.
2. No running, roughhousing, or disruptive behavior will be allowed on the pool deck or in the pool.
3. The cleanliness of the pool area is everyone's responsibility. Trashcans are provided for your use.
4. All members and guests shall be responsible for cleaning up after themselves, including throwing away cups and food containers in the proper trash receptacles once they are finished using them and relocating any furniture back to its original location.
5. All persons that are not bathroom independent trained shall be required to wear an approved swim diaper. It is the Member's responsibility to comply with this rule for his/her children as well as those of his/her Guests. The consequence of accidents is that the pool must be closed for a period of several hours after the incident discovery and necessary cleanup.
6. Ten minutes to every hour will be considered "adult swim" and all children below the age of eighteen (18) must exit all water areas.
7. Holding spots on the pool deck for people who are arriving later in the day is not permissible.
8. State Board of Health Rules are posted, and all members and their guests are expected to read and comply with these rules.

Guests

1. HOA and Pool Members are allowed to bring guests, but all guests must be accompanied by the member, adhere to the same pool rules, and pay guest fees.
2. Guest fees will be:

3. Babysitters and nannies will be permitted to accompany members' children as an extension of the membership but must pay the guest fee and do not have pool privileges without a members' child present. The babysitter/nanny must be at least 18 years of age and must register with the club.

Pool Safety Procedures:

1. Emergency Procedures:

- In the event of an emergency, lifeguards will initiate appropriate rescue operations and alert emergency services as needed.
 - An emergency contact list (including local hospitals and emergency numbers) will be maintained at the poolside.
2. Inclement Weather:
- The pool will be closed during thunderstorms or when lightning is present.
 - The pool will remain closed for 30 minutes after the last sign of thunder or lightning.
3. Injury Reporting:
- Any injury occurring on or around the pool area must be reported to the pool manager immediately.
 - The pool manager will complete an injury report for documentation purposes.

Pool Rental and Special Events

1. Private Pool Parties and Events:
- The pool may be rented for private events, subject to availability and approval by the Pool Manager and Director of Golf.
 - Events must be scheduled for at least two weeks in advance, and the organizer must agree to pool rules and policies.
 - A deposit will be required to secure the reservation.
 - The pool party or event details will be documented in a contract with pricing. More information and pricing will be available in the contract.
2. Rentals:
- Premier Rental
 - i. Timeframe: 6 hours
 - ii. Space: entire pool, sound system, cabanas, firepit area
 - iii. Pool will be closed to outside patrons for the private event
 - iv. Cost: \$1,000
 - Standard Rental
 - i. Timeframe: 4 hours
 - ii. Space: left side of pool area cabanas
 - iii. Pool will continue to be open to members
 - iv. Cost: \$300
